To all golfers,

It is my contention that to learn to play golf correctly, without experiencing a common problem associated with golf instruction called “paralysis from analysis,” students need a **sustained period of “clear and concise” input**. Trying to learn golf in an hour, or even five or six one hour sessions over a few weeks, will not and does not work!

Given sufficient time, an experienced teacher can make a huge difference in a veteran golfer’s game and provide the “new to the game” golfer invaluable assistance that will introduce them to the game in a manner that will keep them in the game for a lifetime.

Over the last several years, with students ranging from beginners to touring professionals, I have conducted a considerable amount of private/semi private half-day and full-day sessions. The results have been extremely promising. In fact, the students felt these experiences were some of the most productive of their golfing careers. Ultimately, the common response was that these sessions provided them with a much more enjoyable and efficient approach to game improvement.

The success of these **sustained periods of instruction** lies in the fact that we have sufficient time to simplify the fundamentals, which most golfers tend to complicate and, during this same time, have the student experience properly struck golf shots. Quite frankly, my goal is to systematically reprogram their perspective and understanding of **Absolutes**. These are facts that cannot be ignored or neglected in the learning and execution of the golf swing. While this obviously applies to the recreational golfer, I am constantly surprised by how this technique simplifies and compartmentalizes even the most talented player’s game improvement plan.

We all have heard “the customer is always right.” If you only have time for a one hour lesson, we’ll oblige and provide you with the best lesson you can get. Just understand, more is better when it comes to learning to play this great game. This is not an attempt at an up-sale. We just want you to see improvement during the lesson and be sure you leave better than when you arrived.

Sure, time and money have a direct influence on your decision. However, please consider that the cost for a series of five or six lessons may be better spent with a great teacher for a few hours that enables you to “get it” while your teacher is standing there with you. You will also go home with the tools to continue to improve and then a few phone calls and an occasional checkup will keep you on track.

After 30 years of helping beginners to PGA and LPGA touring professionals, it has become extremely apparent to me that the average golfer needs only to acquire three basic capabilities: solid contact, direction control, and sufficient distance. If you can't hit it, you don't care about direction. If you can hit it, direction is everything and once direction control is repeatable, you want to hit it far enough! Our staff and I will spend the time needed for you to get these elements under control so you can begin to play with enjoyment and improve with rehearsal and practice.

When you choose a school or program, let us know where your game is now.

Please use the following guide to determine your current level of ability:

LEARNER – 120+

"I have never played or have only tried it a few times."

No understanding of the proper grip and its relationship to the face position at impact. No awareness of alignment. Does not swing in balance. Poor contact is a result of lack of coordination between arm swing, body rotation and weight transfer.

ADJUSTOR – 88 to 100

"I've played for a while, but I can't seem to improve."

Adjusts swing on a daily basis. Attempts to fix different problems each day. Takes advice from playing partners and/or tries to incorporate new tips from TV or magazines. Develops through instinct and personal athletic talent. Grip, stance, and alignment results from ball-flight feedback. Perception of what is right and wrong needs major realignment. Muscle and mental habits need retraining. Ball contact most likely with an open face.

DEVELOPER – 78 to 88

"I'm capable of breaking 80, but I can't maintain that level."

Has committed to a formal instructional program. Ball contact is generally solid but still a variable. A draw or fade preference may have been established. Plays better on home course. May need some minor repositioning of the grip. Must work on staying "linked" in the full swing. Position of the shaft must be addressed during take-away and prior to impact. Transition and release timing can be improved. There are many steps to be taken with this golfer depending on their desire to become a PLAYER.

PLAYER – 72 to 78

"I have success in competition, but I'm capable of 68 one day and 78 the next."

Has developed "how to score" versus "how to swing" mentality. Short game brilliance is paramount. Displays a confidence and understanding about the swing that allows working on visualization, grip pressure, feel, and sensitivity to clubface and path. Studying ball flight ascertains whether control and distance is adequate for shooting lower scores. Perception of alignment may vary. May lose key posture and set-up positions. Quality of practice and proper use of time is important. Ball contact is generally sound, but can slip. There is a need for more competitive playing and generally just more playing time. Game suffers from lack of use, which is mistaken for a swing flaw. Some mechanics are only achieved through a quantity of play.

TOUR PLAYER – 66 to 72

"I need to maintain the lowest possible scoring average."

Plays more INSTINCTIVELY! Excels in all areas of shot making and delivers under extreme pressure. Confidence is a result of capability. Poor play is generally a result of poor visualization techniques, lack of feel, and minor swing faults that are corrected within hours or a few days. Full swing flaws are often discovered in their short swings. Works on percentages. Scoring average is everything.
